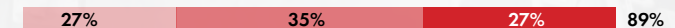

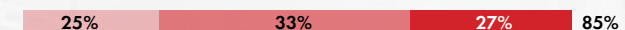

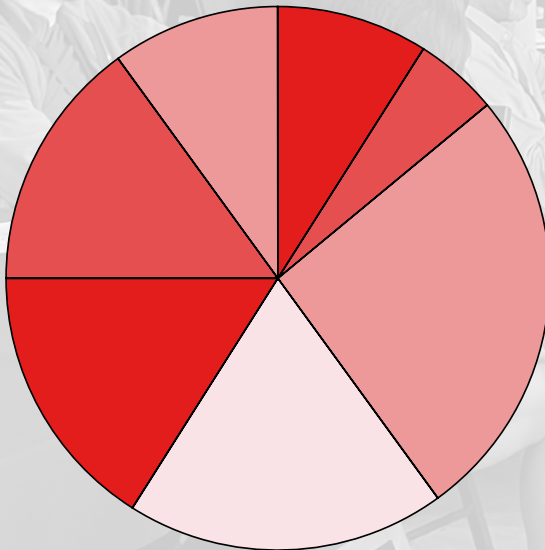
WHO ATTENDS?

ATTENDEES BY TYPE

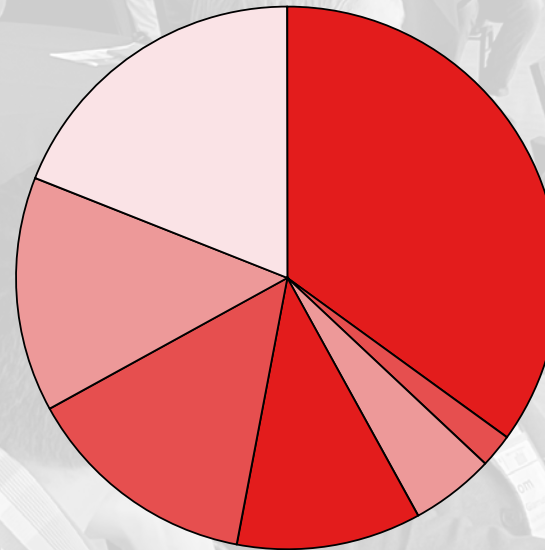
